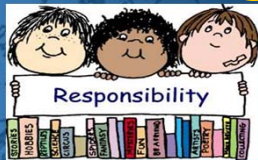

Form DOES NOT change court responsibility, only handling between DCSS offices (advices parties who to notice)

NOT a change of venue

New county CAN/CIT modify child support orders

NOTICE OF CHANGE OF RESPONSIBILITY FOR MANAGING CHILD SUPPORT CASE CASE NUMBER: _____

NOTICE

The responsibility for managing your child support case has changed from one county's local child support agency to a different county's local child support agency. The managing local child support agency listed in item 1 now has the responsibility for enforcing the child support case. You must direct all future letters, telephone calls, questions, or information regarding your child support case to the managing local child support agency listed in item 1.

However, the change in managing local child support agency does **NOT** change the authority of the superior court to hear matters concerning the child support order. All pleadings and court forms must be filed with the superior court listed in item 3 and served on the local child support agency listed in item 2 and on any other party to the case.

NOTE: Responsibility for ENFORCEMENT of child support changes from one county to another;

BUT

Authority of Superior Court to hear matters regarding child support REMAINS IN PRIOR COUNTY.





Scenario #1


- ❖ Case is in Kern Co. NCR filed by San Joaquin Co. If Obligor wants to modify case, where do they file?

SCENARIO #4

The County of San Francisco has an open child support case against Jack Clark. The Other Parent is Jill Clark.

Alameda DCSS files FL-632 (NRPS) and FL-634 (NCR). Did the LCSA file the correct forms?

SCENARIO #5

❖ Susie filed for divorce from Tom in El Dorado. Tom now lives in Sacramento.

❖ Susie immediately went to the LCSA. The LCSA filed their own case as there were no orders in the divorce case. Both cases were later consolidated.

❖ Tom and Susie's children are all emancipated so there is no current child support order. However, there are minimal arrears still owing.
