#### **Funding Scenario Recap**

## Identified **3 scenarios** for FY24-25 funding models for local projects

- Considered branch and local priorities
- \$12.5m available

## **Guiding Principals**

Goal of moving branch forward, rather than a strictly pro rata approach

Take an adaptive and responsive approach

Interest in getting all courts funding, including through alternate sources

Recognize some projects need considerable investment

Focus on concepts versus numbers

Avoid gross funding inequities, overfunding, or outliers

#### **Referrals – Alternative Funding Sources**

#### Referrals

- Courts applied for both IT Mod and Alt fund
- Workstream referred project to Alt fund
  - Staff asked court if they would like to be considered for funding by an alternative sourse

\* Small court floor: The smallest applicant courts that did not receive set aside (off the top) funding, received funding for their highest approved project.

\*\* Pro rata remainder: Distributed the remaining amount to applicant courts with approved projects via a pro rata formula

\*\*\* **Undistributed funding** is the result of completing the three steps above and monitoring for overage.

#### **Option 1: Hybrid Courtrooms**

- Aligns with branchwide priorities
- Can fully fund all projects requested
- Following methodology: Model with the least amount of undistributed funding
